RESOLUTION 15-03**PAGE 1 OF 2****RENEWAL OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES LEVY (6-YEAR LEVY)**

A resolution of the Board of Commissioners of Central Kitsap Fire & Rescue, (referred to herein as "District") providing for the submission to the qualified electors of the District at an election to be held within the District on **April 28, 2015**, a proposition authorizing the continuation of a levy of a regular property tax in the sum of \$.50 per \$1,000 assessed valuation each year for six consecutive years, to be levied each year succeeding the year of the levy, to provide funds required by the District to enable the District to provide emergency medical services in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington, RCW 84.52.069.

WHEREAS: It is the judgment of the Board of Commissioners of the District that it is essential and necessary for the protection of the health and life of the residents of the District that the emergency medical services enumerated in this resolution be provided by the District. Such services will necessitate the expenditure of revenues for maintenance, operations and equipment.

THEREFORE: Be it resolved by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Central Kitsap Fire & Rescue, Washington as follows:

Section 1. That the District shall provide emergency medical care or emergency medical services, including related personnel costs, training for such personnel, and related equipment, supplies, vehicles and structures needed for the provision of emergency medical care or emergency medical services.


Section 2. In order to produce the revenue adequate to pay the costs of providing the life protection services as described in Section 1 of the resolution and assure the continuation of such services, the District shall levy for six consecutive years beginning in 2015 and collect each year for a period of six consecutive years, beginning in 2016, a general tax on taxable property within the District, emergency medical services costs in the amount equal to \$.50 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation.

Section 3. There shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the District for their ratification or rejection at an election on **April 28, 2015**, the proposition (attached hereto as "Appendix A") of whether or not such a levy for emergency medical services, shall be made.


Section 4. The District's attorney is authorized to make such minor adjustments to the wording of such proposition as deemed appropriate or as may be recommended by the Kitsap County Prosecuting Attorney's Office or the Kitsap County Auditor and its Supervisor of Elections, as long as the intent of the proposition remains clear and as approved by the Board of Commissioners.



RENEWAL OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES LEVY (6-YEAR LEVY)

RENEWAL OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PROPERTY LEVY**

Shall Central Kitsap Fire and Rescue be authorized to continue to impose its regular emergency medical services property tax levy equal to fifty cents (\$.50) per thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) of assessed valuation for each year for six (6) consecutive years, commencing in 2015 and collected each year for a period of six consecutive years, beginning in 2016? (Pursuant to RCW 84.52.069 and Central Kitsap Fire and Rescue Resolution 15-03).
