Jackie and Tracey received his email, I don't see that you did. I will forward it to you.



I had the opportunity to watch you in action on Monday evening and was most impressed with your factual and business-like recount of events regarding the gun club.

I find that I have been perhaps missing out on a golden opportunity by not attending your meetings!

During the same Monday evening session, a young lady addressed the subject of safety for bikers. A very sound proposition I sincerely hope the three of you would look into with positive results.

Ten years ago, I addressed with the City of Port Orchard the safety issue of the lack of a sidewalk along Horstman Road connecting Tufts Avenue with Olney Road. Petitions from our 80 homes in the area concerned about pedestrian traffic along Horstman playing tag with the automobile traffic fell on deaf ears. It did not occur to me at that time to also address this with my County Commissioners as half of Horstman Road is in the County!

Would it be possible for the County Commissioners to do something about finally getting a sidewalk built along Horstman to connect with Tufts and Olney? If not out of concern for the adults and seniors walking along the road, then perhaps for the children who have to get off school buses and try to walk home while playing Russian Roulette with the auto traffic, I would sincerely hope you all would place this on your agenda for forthcoming positive action.

Will you be so kind as to share this with your fellow commissioners, or would you rather I sent this same missive to each of them? Would this be sufficient to initiate action, or is this a matter which I should bring up personally at your next meeting?

I am writing to you today in regards to my concerns about Prosecutor Russell D. Hauge's continued misuse of County resources to continue his personal vendetta/persecution of Mr. Marcus Carter and by extension the Kitsap Rifle and Revolver Club.

I question whether his recent actions in the contracting for the services of a Mr. Gary Koon as a subject matter expert on public shooting range safety analysis was a prudent usage of the County's resources. I am writing to you today in regards to my concerns about Prosecutor Russell D. Hauge's continued misuse of County resources to continue his personal vendetta/persecution of Mr. Marcus Carter and by extension the Kitsap Rifle and Revolver Club.

I question whether his recent actions in the contracting for the services of a Mr. Gary Koon as a subject matter expert on public shooting range safety analysis was a prudent usage of the County's resources. I am writing to you today in regards to my concerns about Prosecutor Russell D. Hauge's continued misuse of County resources to continue his personal vendetta/persecution of Mr. Marcus Carter and by extension the Kitsap Rifle and Revolver Club.

I question whether his recent actions in the contracting for the services of a Mr. Gary Koon as a subject matter expert on public shooting range safety analysis was a prudent usage of the County's resources.
