... shall not be individuals who are prohibited, regardless of whether they are using skills.

Section 2. ... Discharge of firearms prohibited. Ordinance 50-A, Section 2, hereby amended as follows:

(1) The discharge of firearms is prohibited within 500 yards of the shoreline of the unincorporated areas of Kirtland.

(2) The discharge of firearms in the unincorporated areas of Kirtland County is further prohibited in the following instances:

- (a) In any area designated as a no-shooting area by the Board of Commissioners of this county under Ordinance 50-A, Section 2, of this amended ordinance, except as provided in subsection (c) of this section.
- (b) In any area within five hundred (500) yards of any building or other structure or collection of buildings, or the storage of firearms or combustible materials.
- (c) From 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset.

Words in this section shall be construed or interpreted as arranging in favor of the individual guaranteed by Article I, section 2 of the state Constitution to bear arms in defense of self or others.

Section 3. Amendments to Section 3. Ordinance 50-A, Section 3, hereby amended to read as follows:

Exceptions. The provisions of Section 2 shall not apply to the discharge of firearms:

- (1) By law enforcement officers, including Nevada State Police, Department of Fish and Wildlife officers, or other law enforcement personnel in the course of their official duties.
- (2) On a range provided that any such range shall be with the criteria for ranges adopted by the Kirtland County Board of Commissioners pursuant to Ordinance 50-A, this amendatory ordinance.
- (3) In the course of law enforcement activities.
- (4) Pursuant to a permit issued by the Nevada State Police Department of Fish and Wildlife.
