

Summary of Public Concerns

Comments
Concerns over Prospect Street if the one-way was to happen: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Visibility- Condition of the Road- Sharp Turns
Suggestion to have a "trial run" of the one-way proposal first
Problem exists for only 15 minutes, twice a day. Why change the whole street for the small amount of time that is effected?
One-way street may cause too much confusion for the area
Suggestion to create a sign that is a right turn only on Park Blvd. as an alternative to the one-way
Concern that the one-way will not solve the issue of parents still making traffic by wanting to drive their children to school
Suggestion to enhance Pathway Park as an alternative to the one-way
If putting urban like amenities such as sidewalks in Suquamish, ample research needs to be done before the implementation of these amenities are placed
Drainage at the intersection of Park Blvd. and Prospect Street could be an issue
During the snow season, cars could be stuck at the Prospect and Park blvd. intersection, due to
Enforcement of the one-way proposal may be difficult
One-way creates problems that do not currently exist such as "drag racing" and high speeds
