



Planning Commission Staff Report

Issue Description: Changes to KCC Titles 21 and 14; removing fees from ordinance

Meeting Date: Nov 17, 2009

Attendees: Larry Keeton, Director, DCD

Action Requested At This Meeting: Consider Public Hearing testimony; conduct Deliberations and provide a Recommendation

Recommendation: Staff recommends that the Planning Commission consider public testimony, deliberate and provide a recommendation in the affirmative for removing fees from various ordinance chapters and adopting fees by resolution. After the Planning Commission's recommendation, staff will present the recommendation to the BCC for discussion and direction.

Justification: Currently, DCD's fees, as well as some Assessors' and Public Works' fees, are noted in various code sections (Titles 14 and 21). To be consistent with County operations, DCD is requesting that fees be adopted by resolution, much like the County budget and budget amendments are. Adoption by resolution and any subsequent amendments would require public hearings and could occur during quarterly supplemental budget hearings as well as the regular budget program.
