

DIVISION XII – SHEEP & FLEECE GOATS

1. Sheep entered must have ear tag or tattoo. All animals must be pre-entered and all animals housed at the Fair are expected to be shown. Withdrawn animals may not be re-entered.
2. In Breed Type, exhibitors may enter a maximum of two entries in any lot.
3. If two or more exhibitors of a breed enter Class H or Class M, they automatically form their own class.
4. Fitting of animals must be done by 4-H members only, with minimal assistance from another 4-H member or Project Leader. Any other person fitting animals will be grounds for disqualification of exhibitor.
5. All exhibitors must enter an Educational Display. Record books must be entered for judging or if not entered, available for inspection at check-in.
6. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded only if competition warrants.
7. Exhibitors showing animals in Breed Type or Market classes must also enter Fitting and Showing contest.
8. Animals may be blanketed only until Champions have been determined.
9. Class and Lot list may not be show order.

MARKET LAMBS

Exhibitors are limited to two single lambs and one pen of three lambs. Lambs dropped after Jan. 1 of the year of the show are eligible to show. A single entry may not be taken from a pen of three.

1. Only wether and ewe lambs are eligible to compete; rams will be disqualified.
2. The minimum weight for lambs will be 90 lbs. for market. There will be a minimum weight of 50 lbs. for feeder class.

There will be no breed classes for market Lambs. Lambs will be weighed at the show and classified according to weight. If there are more than 15 entries, lambs will be divided into two or more classes according to weight.

Lambs will be classified into market grades and placed within grade. Ribbons will be used to designate grades as follows:

- o Prime & Choice – Superior Conformation Blue
- o Prime & Choice – Less Desirable Conformation Red
- o Good Grade White
- o Under Good Grade No Ribbon or Premium

SUPERINTENDENT'S AWARD – Grand Champion and one Reserve Grand Champion for two best fleeces overall

The following rules apply to Class W – Lots 1-9:

1. Exhibitor limited to two fleeces per lot.
2. Fleeces should be skirted and as intact as possible.
3. Fleeces may be tied with paper twine or not as desired. Place in large, clear, unmarked plastic bags.
4. Fibers must be from exhibitor's project animals.
5. Please note: Lot 6 and Lot 8 should be whole fleece, not fleece sample as in the past.
6. Llama, Lot 7 must be in unmarked, sealed **gallon-size** plastic bags.
7. Angora rabbit fleece must be in unmarked, sealed **quart-size** plastic bag.
8. Fleeces may be from rams, ewes, or wethers.
