## SPECIAL DEPARTMENT RULES

1. Removal of any exhibit, prior to dismissal time from display area will be seen as a final act and will result in immediate forfeiture of all premiums, points and privileges by the exhibitor. Further, exhibitor may be suspended from future exhibiting at the Kitsap County Fair.
2. All exhibitors must comply with general rules and open class livestock rules and regulations as printed and approved by the Board of Directors and the Managers of the Kitsap County Fair.
3. Because no entry fees will be charged, no premium money will be awarded in this division.
4. Llama shows will be held on Saturday and Sunday. Exhibitors may choose one day to bring their animal for show.
5. Deadline for entry is August 1<sup>st</sup>. Contact Fair Office for entry forms, which should be filled out and mailed to the Fair office.
6. Llamas arriving for the day show must be on the grounds by 9:00 a.m.
7. All llamas will be subject to a vet check.
8. Any llama that is unmanageable or creates a disturbance will be asked to leave the grounds.

## CLASSES AND LOTS

### Class 1 Obstacle Course

Llama to compete packed or unpacked, through planned obstacle course. May include water hazard, jumps, backing, maze, etc. Consideration made for incomplete attempts.

- Lot 1 EE. Adult (18 & over)
- Lot 2 Llama & Youth (15 – 17 years)
- Lot 3 Llama & Youth (12 – 14 years)
- Lot 4 Youth (11 years and under)

### Class 2 Open Showmanship

Judged on the ability of the handler to present his/her llama at his best. Conformation not counted but manners and good grooming will be.

- Lot 1 Adult (18 & over)
- Lot 2 Llama & Youth (15 – 17 years)
- Lot 3 Llama & Youth (12 – 14 years)
- Lot 4 Youth (11 years and under)
