SPECIAL DEPARTMENT RULES

1. Removal of any exhibit prior to dismissal time, from display area will be seen as a final act and will result in immediate forfeiture of all premiums, points and privileges by the exhibitor. Further, exhibitor may be suspended from future exhibiting at the Kitsap County Fair.
2. An entry fee of \$2.00 will be charged for each animal entered. Mail entry forms and fees to the Fair office by August 1st.
3. Age will be determined by teeth and registration papers (registration papers must be present at time of entry). Lambs shown by breeder do not need papers.
4. Animals must be registered; except lambs, which must be eligible for registry. Purchased lambs must be registered.
5. Exhibitors may enter up to two (2) animals in any one lot.
6. All sheep entered in flock, get or pair lots must also be entered in an individual lot. Get pairs and young flock must be owned by the exhibitor. Registration papers must be recorded in the name of the exhibitor and be presented on the entry day.
7. Where there is no competition, the judge, in his/her opinion, may award 2nd premium in place of 1st.
8. Any class with only one exhibitor will automatically go into Class G or H.
9. In accordance with state law, all Black faced sheep regulated for scrapie identification will be checked upon entry for proper ear tag or tattoo.
10. All animals must have ear tags according to breed requirements.
11. Herdsmanship is required. Cash awards are:
1st \$50.00
2nd \$25.00
