SPECIAL DEPARTMENT RULES

1. Removal of any exhibit prior to dismissal time from display area will be seen as a final act and will result in immediate forfeiture of all premiums, points and privileges by the exhibitor. Further, exhibitor may be suspended from future exhibiting at the Kitsap County Fair.
2. Entry fee shall be \$2.00 for each exhibit with the exception of sows and litter where \$2.00 entry fee will be charged for the sow only. Entry form and fee should be mailed in to Fair office no later than August 1st.
3. It is recommended that swine be vaccinated at least four weeks prior to Fair.
4. Herdsmanship required for all participants.

Class C Sow and Litter

Lot 6 Sow and Litter of six or more pigs under eight weeks of age

Class D Best Pen of Butcher Pigs

Lot 7 Feeder Pigs over 3 months under months and under 200 lbs

Class E Best Pen of Young Pigs

Lot 8 Best pen of young pigs over eight weeks and under six months. Minimum of 4, not more than 6.

Class F No Sale Market Hogs

Lot 9 No sale market hogs
