Authorities concerned about welfare of two month-old baby girl

Port Orchard, Wash. -- Kitsap County Sheriff's patrol deputies and detectives are on the hunt for a 32 year-old North Kitsap woman who is now on the run from authorities with her two month-old daughter. Authorities believe that the infant's life is in jeopardy. Detectives are requesting assistance from the public in locating the woman.

Name: Rebecca Khristean Forrester

Description: 5' 03" height 140 lbs. weight brown hair brown eyes

Marks / scars: tattoo of a unicorn on right ankle


Other factors: heavy pock-marked face and false teeth

Child's name: Serenity Withrow

Background:

- Forrester has a history of physically abusing her children and heavy narcotics usage. She associates with violent felons.
- Forrester has given birth to five children: three daughters aged 13, 7 and 2 months and two boys, aged 6 and 4. She has had all parental rights terminated, by court order, for three of her five children.
- There have been multiple documented investigations of Forrester by Child Protective Services in Washington and Arizona.
- The Sheriff's Office believes that the life of two month-old **Serenity Withrow** is endangered. She was born in a private residence and has not received any type of medical attention. An order was issued out of Kitsap County Superior Court requiring Forrester to relinquish custody of **Serenity** to Child Protective Services. Authorities are concerned for her health and welfare.

- Forrester was last seen in public on Wednesday, May 2, in Poulsbo.
- She is believed to be driving a 2001 Dodge Dakota quad-cab (4-door) pick-up truck, white in color, Washington license **A02765P**.
