

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Kitsap County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing on **June 18, 2007** beginning at the hour of **10:05 a.m.**, in its Chambers, County Administration Building, 619 Division Street, Port Orchard, Washington 98366 to consider an **Ordinance** setting speed limits on **Suquamish Way NE** and further described as follows:

WHEREAS, RCW 46.61.415 provides that the Local Authority may determine and declare reasonable and safe maximum speeds, and

WHEREAS, on the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, the Department of Public Works has determined maximum speed limits on various sections of Suquamish Way NE,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Kitsap County Commissioners, in regular session assembled, that it is the intention of said Board, in the interest of public safety, to have certain regulatory speed limit signs erected as follows:

Suquamish Way NE, beginning at SR #305 for a distance of 6300 ft. east, and ending 500 ft. west of Division Avenue NE, located in Sections 20, 21, and 29, Range 2 East, Township 26 North, W. M., the speed limit shall be 40 mph.

Suquamish Way NE, beginning 500 ft. west of Division Avenue NE for a distance of 1300 ft. east, and ending 150 ft. west of NE South Street, located in Section 21, Range 2 East, Township 26 North, the speed limit shall be 25 mph.

Suquamish Way NE, beginning 150 ft. west of NE South Street for a distance of 700 ft. east to Augusta Avenue NE, located in Section 21, Range 2 East, Township 26 North, the speed limit shall be 20 mph.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this order shall supersede any ordinances to the contrary that may have been passed previously and shall take effect immediately.

ALL THOSE INTERESTED are welcome to attend. **(Please note that hearing start times are estimates and may be impacted by the amount of public input).**
