

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Kitsap County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing on **June 18, 2007** beginning at the hour of **10:05 a.m.**, in its Chambers, County Administration Building, 619 Division Street, Port Orchard, Washington 98366 to consider an **Ordinance** setting speed limits on a portion of **Central Valley Road** and further described as follows:

WHEREAS, RCW 46.61.415 provides that the Local Authority may determine and declare reasonable and safe maximum speeds, and

WHEREAS, on a basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, the Department of Public Works has determined maximum speed limits on various sections of Central Valley Road,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Kitsap County Commissioners, in regular session assembled, that it is the intention of said Board, in the interest of public safety, to have certain regulatory speed limit signs erected as follows:

Central Valley Road, beginning at NW Bucklin Hill Road for a distance of 3662 ft. (.69 miles) north, ending 500 ft. north of NE Paulson Road, located in Sections 14 and 15, Range 1 East, Township 25 North, W. M., the speed limit shall be 35 mph.

Central Valley Road, beginning 500 ft. north of NE Paulson Road for a distance of 10741 ft. (2.03miles) north, ending at NE June Lane, located in Sections 2,3,10,11,14, and 15, Range 2 East, Township 25 North, W. M., the speed limit shall be 45 mph.

Central Valley Road, beginning at NE June Lane for a distance of 1874 ft. (.35 miles) north and west, ending at Hillcrest Street NW, located in Sections 2 and 3, Range 2 East, Township 25 North, W. M., the speed limit shall be 40 mph.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this order shall supersede any ordinances to the contrary that may have been passed previously and shall take effect immediately.

ALL THOSE INTERESTED are welcome to attend. **(Please note that hearing start times are estimates and may be impacted by the amount of public input).**
