The Puget Sound Action Team reports on Kitsap County's unique stormwater and pollution cleanup program in a new publication, *Kitsap County Surface and Stormwater Management Program: A Case Study*.

The Kitsap County Surface and Stormwater Management (SSWM) Program is a partnership of local agencies working together to identify and correct stormwater and other pollution problems. The partnership includes the Kitsap County departments of Public Works and Community Development, the Kitsap County Health District and the Kitsap Conservation District.
