Level III offender's release from incarceration delayed

Port Orchard, Wash. -- The Kitsap County Sheriff's Office is releasing the following information pursuant to RCW 4.24.550, and a Washington State Supreme Court decision in *State vs. Ward*, regarding public notification of the anticipated residency of convicted sexual offenders.

The Sheriff's Office made public notification last week concerning anticipated residency of four Level III sex offenders.

Since then, the Sheriff's Office has received information that the following individual *will not* be released from imprisonment on Jan. 28, as previously announced:

Name: **Donald Lavern Fawver**, white male, age 49.

Fawver will remain incarcerated until further notice. When a future release date for Fawver is known, the Sheriff's Office will make the appropriate community notification.

Fawver has been categorized as a Level III sex offender since he has failed to complete the required sex offender treatment program.

A community notification meeting, concerning the residency of the other Level III sex offenders, is scheduled for 7:00 p.m., Tuesday, Jan. 27, in the Givens Community Center, 1026 Sidney Avenue, Port Orchard. Sheriff's detectives and officers from Bremerton Police Department will be available to discuss the program and to answer questions.
