## Help Requested from Public in Missing Person Case



**Port Orchard, Wash.** – Kitsap County Sheriff's detectives are asking for assistance from the public in locating the whereabouts of a missing person identified below.

**Name:** Harry Walker, age 61

**Race:** African-American

**Description:** Thin build -- 5'05" height, 125 lbs. weight, black hair and brown eyes. Walker is known to wear extravagant clothing such as long, fur coats and brightly colored hats.

**Background:**

Harry Walker is an unemployed and unmarried. He was reported as a missing person by his family. He was last seen in early March.

Walker lives alone in the Navy Yard City neighborhood of Bremerton. Walker is a patient with Kitsap Mental Health; he last saw his case worker on March 4. He does not drive and usually travels via public transportation.

Walker is known to frequent various establishments in downtown Bremerton, such as Monica's Social Club and the Salvation Army. He has recently been attending the Bremerton First United Methodist Church, located at 1150 Marine Drive, Bremerton.

**Action:**

Walker's disappearance is an active investigation by Kitsap County Sheriff's detectives. Information has been provided that Walker may have traveled to Seattle, however this has not been corroborated. There is no indication, at this time, to suspect criminal activity is connected with Walker's missing person status.
