As the Training Sergeant for 5 years Mike was responsible for coordinating the training for the 20-25 member strong COP program. Mike took on several other duties including updating the policy manually, creating a tips and tricks files to help fellow member, streamlining the processing of applicants, and numerous other projects.

The COP program supports the Sheriff's Office by processing abandoned vehicles, junk vehicles, doing vacation house checks, home security evaluations, and educating the public about parking laws.

Mike was voted COP of the year by his peers 3 times and has inspired the unit to operate smoothly and with little supervision by paid staff. Mike's positive attitude, work ethic, and quality of work is an inspiration to his fellow volunteers, paid staff, and greatly appreciated by the unit supervisor.
