## **Accessible Communities Advisory Committee**

- **1. CALL TO ORDER:** Kris Colcock called the meeting to order at 10:01 a.m. via Zoom.
- 2. INTRODUCTIONS: Introductions were made, attendance was taken.

### 3. APPROVAL OF THE May 14, 2024, MINUTES\*

MOTION: Ranae Beeker moved to approve the May 14, 2024; minutes as presented. Amanda Gonzalez seconded. Motion carried.

### 4. PRESENTATION: Steve Gardner, Kitsap County Public Information Officer

There was no presentation during the June ACAC meeting.

#### **5. UPDATES:**

#### a. Juneteenth

 The ACAC will be attending Juneteenth: People's March and Freedom Festival on June 15 from 10a-3p in Bremerton. The People's March begins at the Norm Dicks building and leads to Evergreen Park for the Freedom Festival. Amanda will bring stickers and will help setup while Molly is going to help tear down once the event is complete.

#### b. Clear Creek Trail Ride

• The Clear Creek Trail Ride (CCTR) takes place on July 20 from 10a-12p in Silverdale. Ranae shared that Clear Creek hasn't charged the ACAC in the past for this event, she will be reaching out to get clarification. The ACAC will provide water and have an available first aid kit on hand. Attendees will have the option to choose from a 1-mile trail or a longer 2 mile trail, both in which are paved. Kris mentioned the idea of making the Hippocampe chairs available for the CCTR to offer real world use, Ranae will follow up with this idea.

#### c. Bikes For All event

The Bikes For All event will take place on September 13 from 3p-7p. Skookum has
offered to pay for this year's event, but the location is currently undecided as
Olympic College is unavailable during this time.

### d. Outreach - Brent Rotter

 Brent shared that most farmers markets are now setup, he is in talks with Poulsbo's farmers market in hopes to register for a space in August.  Although Brent's internship has ended Rebecca Pirtle and Brent will continue to meet to help with outreach for the ACAC projects and events.

#### e. City of Poulsbo Proposal for accessible tricycles

• Justin shared that Kelly has been working on the City of Poulsbo contract to extend it from June 30, 2024, to December 31, 2024. Justin noted that they have received invoices from the City of Poulsbo and are hopeful the Tricycles will be ready by the beginning of July in time for the summer concert series in Poulsbo.

### f. Sea Discovery Center accessible door project

• Justin shared that Kelly has been working with Bridget Anderson (Director, Sea Discovery Center) in hopes to begin construction by the end of June. This project has been in the works since August 2023 and the Sea Discovery Center is ready to move forward to get this project completed.
